

To The People's Justice League,

This letter represents the tenants of 149 E. State St, whom your organization has branded neo-Nazis and fascists. Due to these accusations, the tenants of 149 E. State have dealt with harassment, libel, stalking, threats, and other instances of persecution and bigotry.

The basis of these claims stem from the presence of a Roman standard flag upon our balcony. Although true the Italian fascists appropriated ancient Roman symbolism, the original Roman standard holds no affiliation with the fascists groups we have been labeled as. The significant difference in the Roman standard and the fascist appropriation of said standard stems from the inclusion of a fasces, or a bundle of sticks representing the power of collective governance and law. Within the Roman republic, A fasces represented the power and wisdom of a magistrate within the ancient republic. The omission of this critical detail upon our flag demonstrates our non-affiliation with these groups you claim we represent.

Furthermore, one of the tenants recently threw a 21st birthday party with a Roman theme. Most of the tenants of 149 possess an avid interest in history, particularly Roman history. Two tenants possess degrees in history, and all tenants remain interested in the discipline. In your own photograph proving we are "white supremacists" a keg can clearly be seen on the left-hand side of the stairs. We also possess invitations, which we will release assuming respectable discourse with your organization has been established.

We, the tenants of 149 E. State, demand a removal of your malicious article which has caused us much stress and duress. We expect the article on both your Facebook page and official website to be removed in 48 hours, as our address and information has been released to the public without our consent or knowledge. Furthermore, we expect a public apology made out to the tenants of 149 E. State street for the ordeal we have been put through at the hands of your organization. This apology should be posted to the same mediums previously discussed. We would also ask you to produce evidence regarding the allegations of our affiliation with Neo-Nazi or white supremacist identarian groups, as we believe the previous paragraphs proves our innocence.

The discussion of different ideas stands as one of the hallmarks of our great society, and your actions regarding our supposed ties to white supremacists group had dirtied the discourse held to such a high standard. We sincerely hope this letter puts an end to this ordeal, as we want no part of your organization or your witch-hunt mentality. Previous attempts to contact your organization have proved fruitless. We attempted to call and visit your office to no avail. Meanwhile, no one from this organization has reached out to us, but our landlord has received dozens of calls demanding our flag be removed. Not only is this situation preposterous, it is counterintuitive to the causes you claim to represent. If these demands are not met within 48 hours, we will discuss legal action.
